Hospitality Committees –

_____ **Summer Pre-SME Picnic:** Assist with picnic set up, clean up, or grilling.

_____ **Midnight Madness Pancake Breakfast:** Assist with preparing the annual Midnight Madness Pancake breakfast for the entire band and color guard.

_____ **Equipment Committee** – Help set up and tear down prior to football games and competitions. Help load and unload trucks before and after trips. This year we would like this committee to help keep band room organized. After each performance help make sure equipment is returned to its proper place and stored correctly. This will help alleviate lost and damaged equipment. We need dedicated people for this committee. We really count on you to help move your assigned equipment. **There will be a training meeting with a tour of the band room.**

_____ **Uniform Committee:** Help fit students with uniforms during the summer. Help sort uniforms after cleaning. No sewing is required.

_____ **Office Help Committee:** Individuals willing to commit to working 1-3 hours a week during the school year. Will provide assistance with copying, music inventory etc. **Training will be provided in the fall.** Time Commitment: 1-3 hours per week during school year.

_____ **Sewing Committee** –Individuals with sewing background to help hem uniforms, sew flags, etc. Your name will be given to Color Guard Director and Mrs. Evans. **Must be able to sew and helpful to have your own machine.**

_____ **Trailer Committee** – Assist with construction in the trailer, maintain the trailer, etc.
